Due to: Common predators include raccoons, foxes, birds of prey, coyote, etc. Habitat: Domestic chickens use farms and backyards as their habitat

Size: They can range in size from 1.1 pounds to over 11 pounds.

Life Span: 5-10 years

Diet: grains, seeds, insects, invertebrates, fruits

Reproduction: Fertilized eggs hatch after 21 days incubation. Chicks use their beaks and sharp egg tooth (a bump on the tip of the beak) to

break out of the shell.

Did You Know?

It takes 4 or more pounds of feed to make 1 dozen eggs. Chickens lay different colored eggs ranging from white, to brown, to pink, to blue, to green.
