



## **Conservation Status**

Extinct Extinct in the wild Critically Endangered Endangered Vulnerable Near Threatened Least Concern

Due to: Common predators include raccoons, foxes, birds of prey, coyote, etc. Habitat: Domestic chickens use farms and backyards as their habitat

Size: They can range in size from 1.1 pounds to over 11 pounds.

Life Span: 5-10 years

Diet: grains, seeds, insects, invertebrates, fruits

**Reproduction**: Fertilized eggs hatch after 21 days incubation. Chicks use their beaks and sharp egg tooth (a bump on the tip of the beak) to

break out of the shell.

## Did You Know?

It takes 4 or more pounds of feed to make 1 dozen eggs. Chickens lay different colored eggs ranging from white, to brown, to pink, to blue, to green.
